The children will learn about Tim Peake and Neil Armstrong. We will be comparing their space experiences, **looking at similarities and differences.**

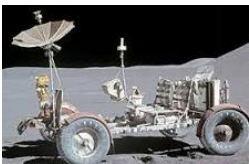
