



## Science

We will be learning about what plants need to grow. We will be planting seeds and bulbs, take care of them and watch them grow.

The children will learn about the main parts of flowers and trees. We will be labelling plants and writing facts. We will also be learning about things that are living, dead and things that have never lived.



## Art

Observational drawing & painting = we will be looking closely at plants, flowers & vegetables. We will then be drawing and painting what we can see.

We will also be learning about printing, create our own printing tiles and make our own prints.

## Computing

We will be practising logging on and logging off. The children will continue to develop their mouse control skills.

The children will be grouping and sorting shapes. We will also be looking at Pictograms and making some on the laptops.

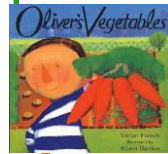


## Literacy
