Computing

We will be using the computers to begin our unit on asking effective questions which will link well to our history unit on Mary Anning.

Maths

We have moved from addition and subtraction onto multiplication and division. The children will recap counting in 2s, 5s and 10s and begin to count in 3s to help them solve their number sentences.

RE

We will be learning about the journey that led to the birth of Jesus.

Science

We will be continuing our work on materials but developing their knowledge into how materials can be changed. We will also be taking part in National STEAM day where the children will have a problem to solve.

PE
