Literacy

We will be reading stories with an animal theme. The children will be writing lists and simple sentences. We will also learn about adjectives and rhyming words.

Kinetic letters – we will be practising holding a pencil correctly, forming numbers and letters in the Jumper family.



Maths

We will be:

- Counting to 50 forwards and backwards.
- Finding 1 more and 1 less when problem solving.
 - Using number lines.
- Measuring length and height
- Problem solving with number bonds
