8/10 enjoy it and said it is fun. 2/10 said no its's not interesting.


What have you learnt?


3- Pupil attitude survey feedback

Last half term you all completed a pupil attitude survey. We unpicked a few of the answers to check children's understanding and reasons behind some possible negative feedback.

5. How do you feel about being at school



I asked the children why they felt some children would feel sad, angry or worried at school. They said that some children miss their mummies and daddys and that would make them feel sad. They said they may feel worried due to the unsafe behaviours of some children making them feel worried about being in school. They also said that lots of children don't enjoy learning times but enjoy cool time.




Every time I see children that have hurt me so it makes me feel unsafe, but the teacher sorts it out for me'. 'I've been hurt by a lot of people I'm not sure if the teacher sorts it out'. 'Last year someone has bullied me every day for a few days but they have now moved school. We had a long discussion over the difference between being unkind and bullying.

Another child said "I feel unsafe as I am clumsy!"




I asked the children why some children may feel the teachers sometime make other children feel sad, upset or worried. The said probably because they dont let them do what they want all of the time. Another said maybe because they say no. Another said maybe because they have to tell them what to do to follow the rules.



I asked why other children may make Children feel sad angry or worried. They said that some children are unkind, other children aren't very helpful. Some the behaviours of children make you feel sad, angry or worried.



I asked why children may feel Uncomfortable at school . A few children said I miss my mummy and daddy. Another child said maybe if they are new maybe other children didnt welcome them. Another child said maybe because they haven't been RR in a long time.



I asked the children why some children may feel theybare not listened to. They said it is probably because they are busy and have lots of jobs to do. Sometimes we all talk to the teachers at the same time so they cant hear us!

You have mentioned behaviour several times. I asked 'Do you think behaviour is bad in our school?' 7/10 said yes And 5/10 said it could be better.
